Bandon's Good Earth Community Garden (GE) is a satellite garden of the South Coast Community Garden Association (SCCGA). Anyone 18 years or older may rent a plot at Good Earth and must also apply for membership with the SCCGA. Plots are rented on a first-come, first-served basis. If all plots are rented when your application is received, you'll be placed on a wait list. *Full or partial fee reductions are available.*

### To participate, please do the following:

1. Complete the Good Earth Garden Plot Application below (\$35).
2. Complete the separate SCCGA Membership Application (\$10 for each gardener, 18 years and older).
3. Read the Rules and Guidelines document.
4. Submit the applications and payment as follows:

### Applications and payment may either be submitted online or by USPS mail.

Online Applications: Complete **BOTH** applications and pay the \$45 fee (or more for additional gardeners) securely online. Mailed Applications: Send **BOTH** applications and a check payable to Good Earth Community Garden for \$45 (or more for additional gardeners). **Mail your two signed applications and your check to:**

Applications will be accepted as of February 1st and the garden opens for planting on March 15th. Gardening may begin after that date if completed forms and fees have been received and new gardeners have attended an orientation. You'll be contacted after receipt of your application. The garden closes on December 1st.
